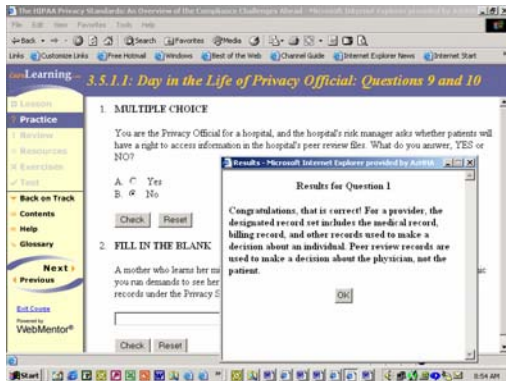

## The HIPAA Privacy Standards: Guidance for Executives (AZC00104) Produced by the Arizona Hospital and Healthcare Association

By April 14, 2003, the HIPAA Privacy Standards will require sweeping changes in the way healthcare providers, health plans, and healthcare clearinghouses do business. This comprehensive web-based course, which features five learning modules, is an outstanding teaching tool for healthcare professionals who need to know the key requirements of these standards. The course provides background on the Privacy Standards, summarizes the provisions of the final Privacy Standards, and suggests ways of tackling HIPAA compliance in your organization.
