



Technical Requirements for *careLearning.com*

The 13 courses that currently make up the *Health & Safety Compliance Training* series are multimedia-based training courses that utilize motion and sound via 'Flash' to deliver content over the Internet. Consequently, you will need a personal computer(s) equipped with:

- A sound card with up-to-date sound drivers
- Access to the Internet with any connection above a 56K. (Note: a 56K dial up connection will not be adequate for course viewing of this series)
- Up-to-date Web browser such as Netscape 5+, Internet Explorer 5+, or AOL 5+
- Up-to-date version of Macromedia's Flash software (a free download)
- Windows 98, 2000, ME, NT, or XP (there are some known bugs with Flash and Windows 95 that can cause sub optimal performance)

As with most personal computing applications, your *careLearning* experience will be optimized by using a faster computer, with up-to-date software and a quality Internet connection.

Additionally, your *careLearning* tracking and reporting software, the Administrative Management System (AMS) will reside locally on either a single PC or the organizations network. The AMS can be used by most any PC which has Microsoft Access installed. The *careLearning* AMS supports either **Access 2000, or 2002**. The AMS ships at around 12mb and it is recommended that the PC or network server have about 50-75mb of available space. For backup purposes we highly recommend the AMS be installed on a server that is backed up on a regular basis.

NOTE:

The AMS is only used for administrative purposes and is not used by your employees to take the courses. The computers the employees use to train do not need Microsoft Access. The AMS does not require or need a dedicated server.

If you can not under any circumstances upgrade to Access 2000 or 2002, then *careLearning* will be able to support an Access 97 version of the AMS, however it is limited in capability. Please contact *careLearning* for details if you fall into this scenario.
