RELATED BOARDS

HOSPAC Board of Directors

HOSPAC's mission is to improve and protect the health care delivery system by helping to elect hospital friendly candidates. HOSPAC works to build grassroots connections between our hospital leadership and elected officials; sets the direction for the funding of the PACs, continually reaches out to meet and improve relationships with elected officials and makes final endorsement decisions.

THA POLICY COUNCILS

Behavioral Health Council

To discuss and make policy recommendations to the Council on Policy Development regarding behavioral health care issues affecting hospital members that provide behavioral health services.

Quality and Patient Safety Council

To address the ongoing opportunities to improve clinical quality, workforce and patient safety of health care in Texas hospitals and develop proposed policy positions for THA as well as advise on the clinical leadership perspective to advance the quality and accountability as it relates to patient care and safety.

Rural Hospital Council

To discuss and make policy recommendations to the Council on Policy Development regarding rural health care issues affecting rural hospital members.

THA POLICY COMMITTEES

Policy Committee on Hospital Contracting and Payment

Study public policy issues relating to hospital billing and collections with governmental and private payers and the review and payment of hospital services and offer recommendations on policy positions to the Council on Policy Development and the THA Board of Trustees.

Policy Committee on Hospital Reimbursement

MEMBERSHIP ENGAGEMENT FORUMS

Communications Council

Provides a forum for collaboration to help THA and its member hospitals manage issues through strong, coordinated communications tools. The council provides an environment for hospital leadership to share best practices and successes regarding communication, marketing and media relations. It serves as a central hub for collaboration and guidance on key issues, including crisis communication, affecting Texas hospitals and the health care industry. The council also discusses areas of focus for social media channels, Texas Hospitals magazine, opinion pieces and other channels.

Hospital Physician Executives

Provides a forum for hospital physician executives to discuss issues and developments that impact the delivery of health care services, including clinical integration, hospital-physician relationships, patient safety and quality improvement; and provide knowledge and expertise to assist THA in the development of public policy positions.

Emerging Leadership Forum (Formerly Leadership Development Council)

Provides networking and leadership training opportunities for emerging health care leaders in THA member hospitals including an understanding of the advocacy and public policy role of the THA Board of Trustees
