

Chrome

1. Open a new browser tab and type `chrome://plugins/` and hit enter
2. Locate *Chrome PDF Viewer* and click *Disable*
3. Close the tab

Mozilla Firefox

1. Click the menu button and choose Add-ons. The Add-ons Manager tab will open
2. In the Add-ons Manager tab, select the Plugins panel
3. Select the *Adobe Acrobat*
4. Select *Never Activate* in its drop-down menu
5. Close the tab

Internet Explorer

1. Open the desktop, and then tap or click the *Internet Explorer* icon on the taskbar
2. Tap or click the *Tools* button, and then tap or click *Manage add-ons*
3. Under *Show*, tap or click *All add-ons*, and look for *Adobe PDF Reader*
4. If *Adobe PDF Reader* is visible, tap or click *Disable*, and then tap or click *Close*
5. If *Adobe PDF Reader* is not visible, under *Show*, tap or click *Run without permission*, and look for *Adobe PDF Reader*
6. Tap or click *Disable*, and then tap or click *Close*

Once the Browser PDF Viewer has been disabled, the document can be downloaded to the computer, double clicked to open in Adobe Reader, and the comments will be visible and printable.
