

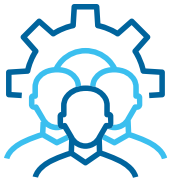


# LDC

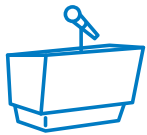


## Sponsor the Texas Hospital Association's Leadership Development Council and engage with Hospital Leaders seeking growth in leadership.
