Overview

- · Identify and address gaps in key areas of engagement and advocacy among local or state government or other leadership organizations in the community.
- Provide actionable steps to address or improve the specified topic/issue.



Deliverables



Executive summary – One-page overview of proposed topic



Testimony – Each program participant will participate in a mock legislative testimony, presenting a key component of their capstone subject.




White paper – Each group will provide a white paper on their specified topic.



Presentation – two to three projects will be selected for a panel presentation at THA's Annual Conference in 2024 in Dallas.

Example: Problem Statement

- Topic: Future Impact of Contract/Agency Labor
- Statement: Labor costs are on an unstainable path, exacerbated by exorbitant contract labor costs that hospitals increasing rely on to maintain minimum safe staffing levels. Reliable public policy can be used to reduce the amount of contract agency costs and protect hospitals' operational margins that allow for provision of safety net services.



Example: Narrowing Your Focus

- Topic: Health Care Coverage
 Focus: Impact of Deceptive Marketing on Patients' Medical Bills from Alternative Health Products
- Topic: Public and Community Health
 Focus: Increasing awareness and early detection of colorectal cancer can save lives and money.
