




Local Provider Participation Funds in Texas

32 local jurisdictions
have legislative
authority to operate

participation funds.**




Since 2013, cities and counties across the state have legislative approval to operate local provider participation funds for the purpose of generating a source of the non-federal share of supplemental Medicaid payments.

Through an LPPF, local governments impose an assessment, not to exceed 6%, on the net patient revenue of private hospitals in a particular jurisdiction. LPPFs are created with specific legislative authority to allow the local jurisdiction to tailor LPPF requirements and authorized uses to the needs of their community.

A law passed in 2019 allows certain government entities to temporarily establish an LPPF. Local government entities have authority to administer the LPPF for only two years. The LPPF expires Sept. 1 following the second anniversary of its authorization. The Texas Legislature must take statutory action to continue the LPPF.

The Texas Hospital Association supports hospitals in pursuing LPPFs as a solution to local health care challenges.
