Texas Hospital Association Dues Structure for 2025-2026 ACTIVE MEMBERS

The Dues Structure for 2025-2027 was approved by the Board at its May 2024 Meeting. Independent hospitals/systems that experience an increase from the 2024 rebasing of expenses of more than \$4,000/\$40,000, are subject to a three-year phase-in, with 50 percent of the increase applied for FY 2025; 25 percent, for 2026; and 25 percent, for 2027.

For 2025-2026, system dues are based on the combined 2022 operating expenses for all hospitals in the system or organization as reported to the TDSHS/America Hospital Association/THA survey for each hospital. Expenses are applied to the tiered dues rate structure specified below. All hospitals that do not have reported expenses will be billed \$5,305.00 annually until expenses are made available. System dues are calculated based on the composition of the system on August 2025, or at the time of application for membership. The non-deductible portion of THA dues for 2025-2026 is 6.99%.

If a member system also manages hospitals, and all managed hospitals are members, the managed hospitals' expenses may be aggregated with the member's expense for the calculation of dues. Otherwise, each managed hospital is eligible for membership as an independent hospital. All hospitals within a system must be active members in THA in order for the Multi-System to be a Type 2 member.
